

Observations of Team:

Commendations:

1. Curriculum of all programs offered by the college is based on CBCS system. POs, PSOs and COs are included in the syllabus.


2. Courses having focused on employability and skill development have been incorporated.

3. Various Value added courses was conducted; Basic Computer course, Communication Skill, Sand Art,

Terracotta Jewelries making, Food Preservation, portrait making and Painting by the various departments of the college.

4. Academic calendar, time table Action Plan and lesson plan prepared by all the departments and faculty members.

- 5. Teacher student ratio of the college is 21:1 (very good).
- 6. Remedial classes mentoring are done by the faculty members for all students.



7. The teaching learning pedagogy involves experiential learning such as projects, assignments, group discussions, seminars, field visits & educational tours by all the departments..

8. ICT enabled teaching pedagogy is followed by all the departments.

9. Students of the college are participating in National, State, Regional and University level sports cultural and curricular events.

10. Several workshops, Seminars, Guest lectures, Group discussions, Quiz competitions, Speech competitions, Debates, Essay writing, Rangoli/ Mehandi competitions Food fare competition and Exhibitions have been organized by the college in the assessment year



11. Several MoUs signed by the college with different Institutions/Organizations.

12. Alumni Association offered by the college is recognized by the Society Act.

13. The faculty members of the college are attending professional development program, seminars and workshops regularly.



14. Most of departments having departmental library.

15. The effort of IQAC and Placement cell for student's placements are commendable.

16. The facility given to the students like common room, canteen, and Sport facilities are adequate and good

17. The Steps taken by the Department of Fine art to motivate students for painting is also commendable.

18. Department of Fine Art , Computer Application, Political Science, History ,Home Science and Education conducted the educational tour and industrial visit.

19. Sensitization programs on cross cutting issues like gender equality, Environmental awareness, Human Values and professional Ethics was organized by the Political Science, Sociology ,Hindi, Sanskrit, Home Science, History and Education department.

20. The performance of the students of Music Department during the visit was excellent.

21. The Efforts of Department of Education, Home Science, Political Science in the field of research and publication are commendable.

21. Feedbacks were obtained on curriculum, teaching learning evaluation process from various stakeholders and analysed by the Feedback committee and recommendations were incorporated in strategic planning.

Recommendations:

- Prepare the syllabus of all the certificate courses conducted by the Department of Home science, Music Computer Science, Political Science, Education, Ancient History and keep safe the digital copy of the certificate issued to the students on completion of the course.
- 2. Before running any certificate courses, it is necessary to have a circular/notification.
- 3. After conducting any course or certificate course, feedback must be taken from the students related to it.
- 4. All the plans related to institutions should be mentioned in the academic calendar.
- 5. From safety point of view, gas pipeline should be installed in the home science laboratory and commercial gas connection is also necessary.
- 6. A suggestion is proposed to establish an incubation center in the Home Science Department.
- 7. There is a need to start certificate courses in the education department.
- 8. It is necessary to conduct educational activities through ICT classes.
- 9. There is a need to work on MoUs with other educational institutions.
- 10. There is a need to start a student E-magazine which will also be uploaded on the college website every month.
- 11. Activate SOUL software access in computer laboratory.
- 12. The Computer Science Department should conduct academic and administrative training programs for teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 13. There is a need to develop software related to political survey by the Department of Political Science.
- 14. It is necessary to keep the digital copy of the certificate issued to the students of all the certificate courses conducted by Department of Political Science.
- 15. There is a need to improve the time table prepared by the Commerce Department keeping in mind the CBCS system prescribed by NEP.
- 16. There is a need to work better on PO, CO and PSO by the Commerce Department.
- 17. There is a need to run the educational activities smoothly through the MoU signed by the Commerce Department.
- 18. There is a need to enrich the academic activities of the History Department through Archaeological Science.
- 19. The History Department has proposed suggestions to conduct educational activities through Power Point presentation.
- 20. Language Lab is required to establish in Department of English.
- 21. There is needed to start Certificate courses in Department of English.
- 22. The Fine arts department is required to display photographs of all national heroes.
- 23. There is a need to start a digital e-magazine related to art and craft by the Fine Arts Department.
- 24. There is a need for the Fine Arts Department to increase its cooperation for the up-liftment of the institution.
- 25. All the paintings displayed on the walls require captions so that anyone can get the necessary information related to the paintings.
- 26. Department of Fine Art is required to start short term courses on painting.
- 27. There is also a need to conduct certificate courses on instrumental subjects by the Music department.
- 28. There is a need to run induction programs for students under the leadership of the library.

- 29. There is a need to conduct courses on the topic "How to use e-Library" by the library.
- 30. Teachers of all departments should prepare e-content and upload it on Uttar Pradesh Digital Library and other necessary MOOC platforms.
- 31. There is a need to add Table Tennis game in the institution to the list of indoor games while promoting the game.
- 32. Installation of MIS system is required to upgrade the activities related to E-Governance.
- 33. Online resources by the faculty to be developed.
- 34. Communication Skill and personality development training should be provided to the students to secure jobs and to pass competitive exams
