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Lesson Plan :

➤ Introduction (10 minutes)

- Introduce the concept of agencies of education.
- Ask students to share their initial thoughts.

➤ Direct Agencies 15 minutes)

- Discuss direct agencies :
- Family
- School
- Teachers

Indirect Agencies 15 minutes)

➤ Discuss indirect agencies:

- Media
- Religion
- Community
- Government

Assessment :

- Participation in class discussions and activities
- Written reflection and self-assessment
- Observation of student engagement and critical thinking

Extension :

- Invite guest speakers from various agencies to share their perspectives.
- Ask students to create visual

projects

(e.g., infographics, diagrams) illustrating the agencies of education and their relationships.

The End



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1. Introduction (5 minutes)

Begin with a thought-provoking question: "What is education?" Write students' responses on the board.

2. Perspectives on Education (20 minutes)

Present quotes or statements from various thinkers, philosophers, and educators (e.g., Plato, John Dewey, Paulo Freire).

Ask students to discuss in small groups:

- What do these perspectives have in common?
- How do they differ?

Which resonates with you the most?

3. Reflecting on Educational Goals (20 minutes)

Distribute the handout with guiding questions:

What do you hope to achieve through education?

What values do you want to develop?

- How will education impact your life?

Have students write their reflections and share in small groups.

4. Conclusion (5 minutes)

Ask students to share key takeaways from the discussion.

Summarize the importance of understanding the meaning of education.

Assessment

Observe student participation during discussion.

Review their written reflections for understanding.

Extension

Invite a guest speaker to share their perspective on education.

Ask students to create a visual representation (e.g., Poster, infographic) of their educational goals and values.
